



SMALL GROUPS:

We provide different types of small groups with their own unique purpose to help you grow in your walk with Christ and others. Our desire is to see every person attending First Bentonville involved in at least one of these groups.

DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS (D-GROUPS)

D-groups help provide an essential environment for every believer to have intimate friendships, accountability, and a life rooted deeply in God's Word.

These groups are gender-specific groups of 5-8 men or women who meet weekly for the purpose of accelerated spiritual transformation through the application of the spiritual disciplines.

LIFE GROUPS

Life groups are groups of individuals who meet to grow and foster a biblical community. These open groups are generally made up of individuals who are going through the same season of life and looking for a place to belong, believe and become a part of something bigger than themselves.

CYCLES

CYCLES are a seasonal series of short-term topical study groups designed to assist believers in their spiritual growth and development. These classes center around core truths every Christian needs to know; habits to a healthy walk with Christ; how to discover your calling and how to share your story, as well as classes on marriage and parenting.

OUR GOALS

- We want to begin to upgrade and expand our ministry tools. (sound systems, video, building and parking, etc.) Therefore, we desire to see \$2M invested in kingdom expansion for the overall vision.
- Plant 5 self-sustaining churches in the next 10 years. In addition, we desire to partner with numerous church plants.
- We want to engage 100 subdivisions with personal outreach.
- We want to have 100 missional small groups engaged in our community.
- We desire to expand our online reach to three languages to increase the Kingdom's influence around the world. (Spanish, Portuguese, and French)
- In 2024 we desire to see 60% of First engaged in the Abiding Life journey.
- We want to see 25% of the church engaged in Partner's in Prayer ministry.
- We desire to expand our volunteer impact by 50% by the end of 2024.

GENEROSITY CHANGES EVERYTHING

Our 15:5 Goal: \$2 million

God is generous and He calls us to be as well. What we do with what God has given us shows the world where our hearts are and helps proclaim the gospel. We want to glorify God with every area of our lives, and that includes what we do with our finances.

Each step of the journey represents growth in a lifestyle of generosity and sacrifice.

GIVING JOURNEY

INITIAL GIVER: Deuteronomy 16:17

An INITIAL GIVER is someone who decides to give for the first time, out of a response to God's Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something and trust God and the leaders of the church with this gift.

CONSISTENT GIVER: 1 Corinthians 16:2

A **CONSISTENT GIVER** is someone who decides to give something and to give it on a consistent basis to exercise the discipline of giving. Often, someone who decides to make their gift an online recurring gift will be someone who is learning the behavior of consistency. Non-online givers can be consistent givers as well, of course; it just requires more discipline.

INTENTIONAL GIVER: Luke 14:28-30

An **INTENTIONAL GIVER** is someone who thinks about giving in relation to their other financial priorities. This giver starts to make giving an intentional choice that reflects how to prioritize it in relation to other things on which they spend money.

A **SURRENDERED GIVER** is someone who recognizes the power of the gospel and is surrendered to honoring God with 100% of their resources as a result. A surrendered giver is someone who gives in a way that changes them, in a way that reflects that their giving is governing their spending/ saving rather than their spending/saving governing their giving. A surrendered giver isn't just concerned with what they **ARE** giving but is more concerned with what they're **NOT** giving and why. They seek to honor God with **ALL** He has given them, whether that means direct monetary giving or a God-honoring use of an existing resource.

ETERNAL GIVER: Luke 21:1-4

An **ETERNAL GIVER** is someone who is thinking about the long-term effect of generosity rather than just the short-term of month-to-month generosity or even year-to-year. An eternal giver makes decisions in the short-term that have long-term effects as it relates to their capacity for generosity. An eternal giver thinks of what home they buy, what car they purchase, how much savings they choose to keep, all in relation to their generosity. An eternal giver is driven by the things of eternity, putting hope in God and not in the things of this earth.



WHAT IS A VOLUNTEER?

Volunteers are people who partner with our ministry and take great pleasure in opening the way for others to experience Jesus. Every Christ-follower is uniquely gifted by God and vital to the health and effectiveness of Christ's body.

Volunteers see and serve the people they encounter through our church and the community. Here at First, we strive towards utilizing every available means to reach a city, the nation, and the world.
